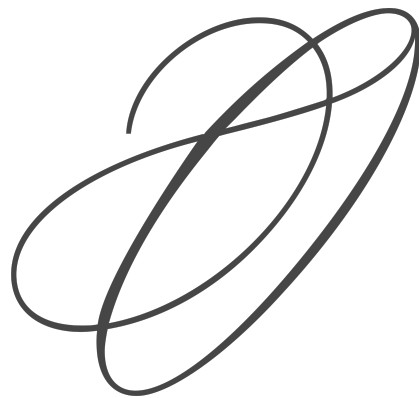

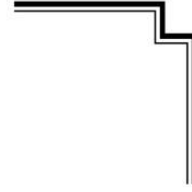

CHAMPAGNE



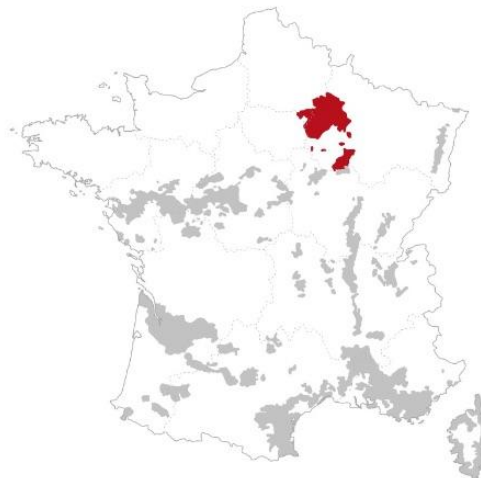
Champagne is the main crown jewel of France, being the most highly regarded wine region in the world, equal with Bourgogne.

Champagne has an incredibly rich history dating back to the 5th Century when the region was making still wines for the Roman Empire. The first wines of Champagne were thin, light red wines made in competition for the much heavier reds coming from Italy. Sparkling wines were not created until the middle of 1500s.

Champagne is comprised of 5 main sub-regions, the Aube (Côte des Bar), Montagne de Reims, Côte des Blancs, Côte de Sézanne, and the Vallée de la Marne.

Champagne comprises, most commonly, of three varieties; Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier.

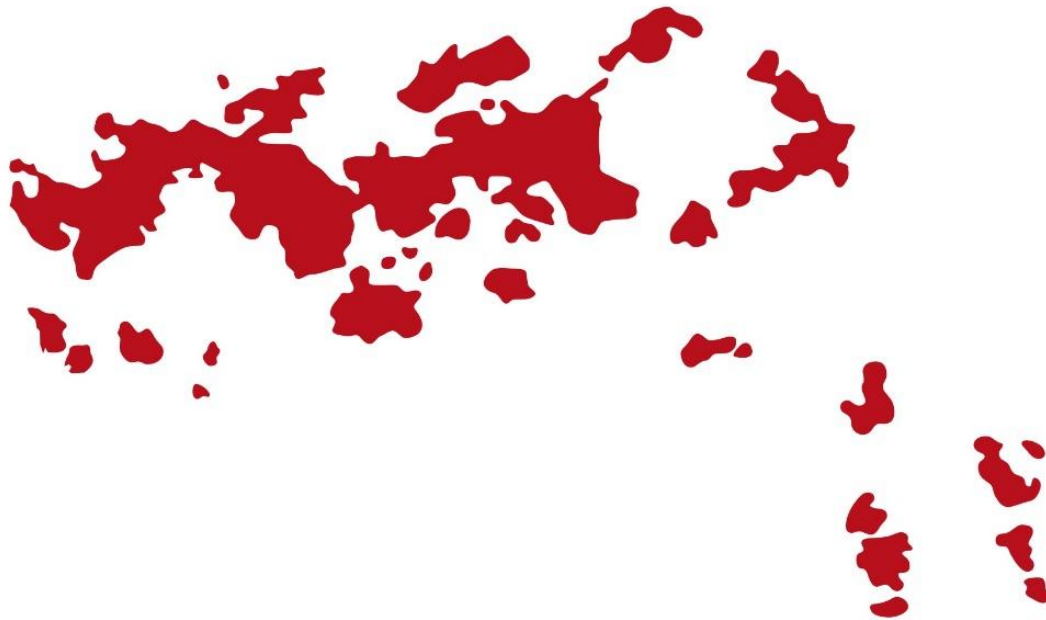

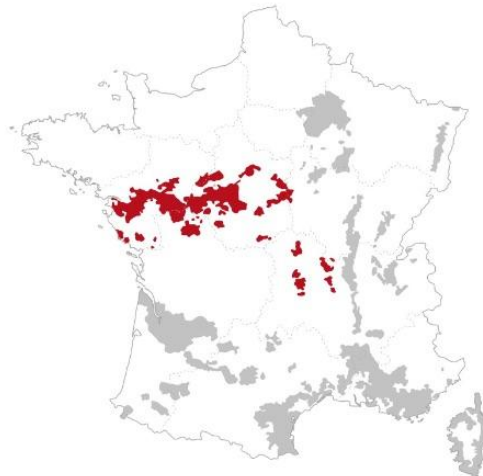
VALLÉE DE LA LOIRE



The Loire valley stretches From the coastal village of Nantes to the middle of France following the Loire River. 95% of all Chenin Blanc grown in France comes from the Loire valley making it the most important variety for the area. It is also the longest river in France spanning 1021 kilometres.

Chenin Blanc, Sauvignon Blanc and Melon de Bourgogne make up the bulk of Loire Valley wines with the most common reds being Cabernet Franc and small portions of Pinot Noir.

The most famous regions are Muscadet on the coast making clean, fresh, white wines from Melon de Bourgogne which are perfect for oysters. Saumur which most commonly produces Chenin Blanc and Cabernet franc, with Vouvray being the most well-known region in the central Loire producing Chenin Blanc also. Sancerre sits in the far eastern corner of the Loire valley focusing on Sauvignon Blanc and offers a completely different style to what we are used to here in New Zealand.

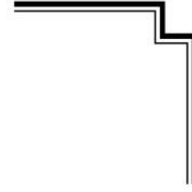

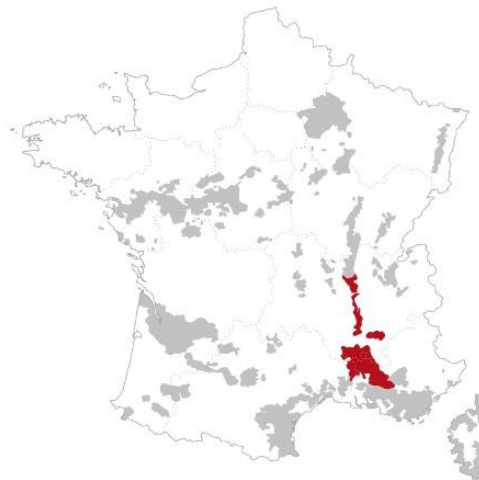
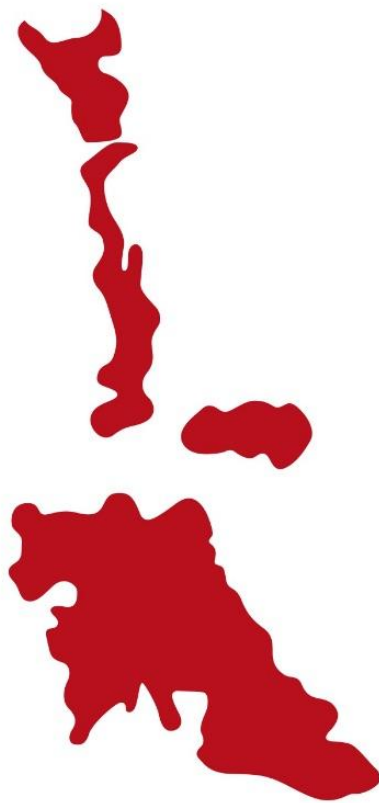

VALLÉE DU RHÔNE

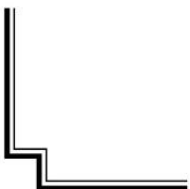


The Rhone Valley is split into 2 sub-regions, Northern Rhone and Southern Rhone. The reds that are produced in the South are most commonly found as blends. These blends are mostly Grenache or Syrah dominant depending on the area. With the whites also being blends consisting of Roussanne, Marsanne and Viognier. The reds are perfectly constructed with juicy, fruit driven cores and spice notes. They are fantastic paired with food and are the highlight on any table for the drinkability and friendliness of the wine.



The whites are considered to be much more medium to full bodied with an almost oily like structure and a core of apricot and almond notes.

The North is more focused on Syrah and creates some of the best Syrah in the world, if not the best. The more famously known sub-region of Cote Rotie (Roasted Slopes) which sits at the very top of the Rhone Valley is home to the best of these Syrahs. Quite often the Syrah will be blended with Viognier to add to the overall structure of the wine and highlight the spice and fruit aromas of the Syrah.

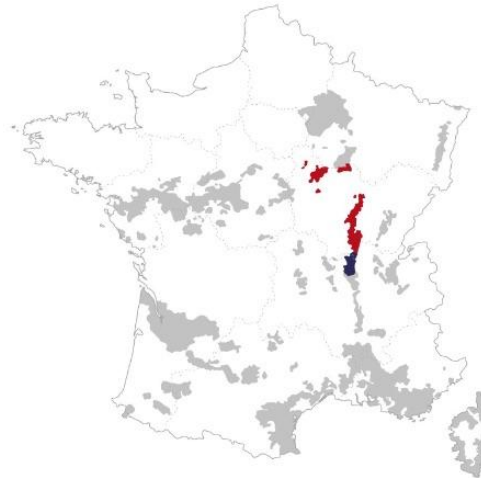

BOURGOGNE & BEAUJOLAIS

Burgundy is like nothing else, elegant, powerful, the powerhouse of the French wine world. From Grand Cru Romanee Conti fetching hundreds of thousands of dollars at private auctions to counterfeit wines being made in replacement to dupe the Burgundy loving wine buyer with cash to burn.

Burgundy is made up of 5 primary wine growing regions, Chablis, Côte de Nuits (the night slopes), Côte de Beaune (the slope of Beaune), Côte Chalonnaise (the Chalon slope), Mâconnais (the region of Mâcon). Then you have Beaujolais to the far south, which, in itself, is its own appellation, but in this instance, we will include it with Burgundy.



The only grape varieties that you need to remember for this region are Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, this has to be the easiest part about Burgundy! Chardonnay is typically and most commonly known as the fresh, mineral white from Chablis. But, styles vary up and down the Burgundy region. From the delicate and soft styles of Northern Burgundian Chardonnay. To the richer and broader Chardonnay of the South.

Pinot Noir on the other hand is predominantly grown in the Côte de Nuits (North) making it the most famous region for Red Burgundy. It is home to some of the most expensive vineyard real estate in Burgundy making it the most sought after region.

ALSACE & JURA & SAVOIE

These 3 appellations lie on the east of France and share a border with Germany. They all have an incredibly rich history especially during the first and second World Wars with the regions being used as access points for the German Military. More specifically, Alsace was annexed by Nazi Germany during 1940 and was known as Elsass. It was not liberated until 1944 closer to the end of the war. Alsace was a pivotal point for Nazi Germany as it was the easiest entry point for the military and the most important strategically.

The wines of Alsace are clear and concise and varietal specific, with the most important being Riesling followed closely by Pinot Gris, which was formerly known as Tokay d'Alsace until the Hungarians made a fuss about it being too closely linked to their own wine region, Tokaj. Alsace is the most well known appellation in France for aromatic wines, but still to this day, in the shadow of the powerhouse of the Aromatic wine world, Germany.



Jura is unlike any other region in France. The wines are purposefully oxidised, light, extremely fresh and incredibly expressive of the region. Once you have had a wine from Jura, you will remember it forever. The key varieties are, Chardonnay, Savaginin, Poulsard, Pinot Noir and Trousseau. These varieties are all very similar in style to Burgundy thanks to clippings of vines being taken to Jura in the Middle Ages.

Savoie is the only alpine wine region in France, this is why the region is most famously known for its skiing and hiking and less for its wine making. Savoie only equals 0.5% of the total wine produced in France. The wines of this region are direct and expressive of the variety with 70% of the region being white wines.

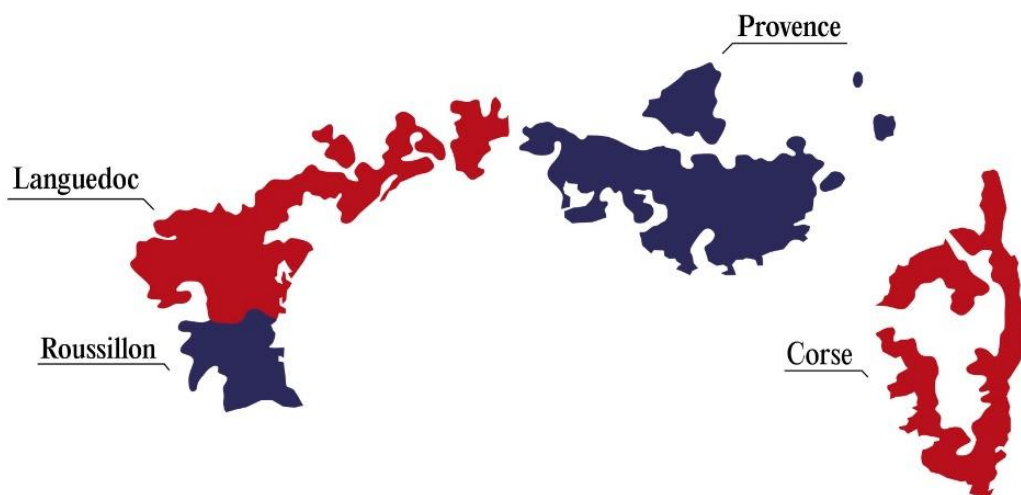

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LANGUEDOC & ROUSSILLON PROVENCE & CORSE

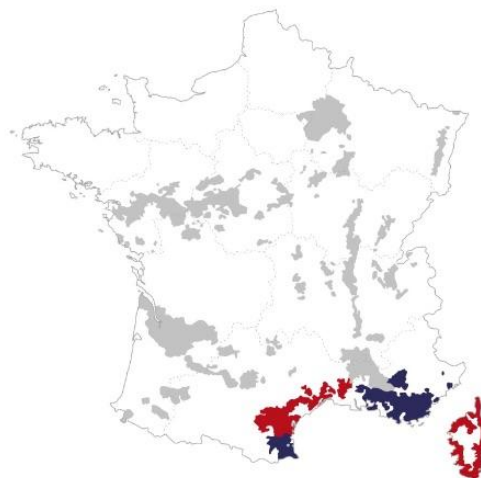


The Languedoc-Roussillon is the largest region in terms of production and size in France. With 700,000 Acres of vineyards, it is the single largest wine producing region in the world and equates to a third of all of the wines produced in France.

The Languedoc-Roussillon area is home to numerous grape varieties with both native and international varieties present. The most important of these being Chardonnay, Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre and Cinsault. The wines produced from the red varieties are often very structured wines with strong tannins and fruit driven palate thanks to the warm Mediterranean climate where the region is located.

Provence: Famously known for dry rose wines, Provence is a mediterranean influenced region with far more to it than just dry rose. The reds from Provence endure the long hot summer days of ripening to create spicy, full body red wines, although these are blanketed by the Provence roses which make up half of the overall production.

Corsica is a small island in the mediterranean which lies 90 kilometres to the west of Italy and 170 kilometres southeast of France. This small island has wine history dating back to 570 BC and had a jump of fourfold in vineyard area during the 1960s. The most common varieties grown are Sangiovese, Sciaccarello and Vermentino.

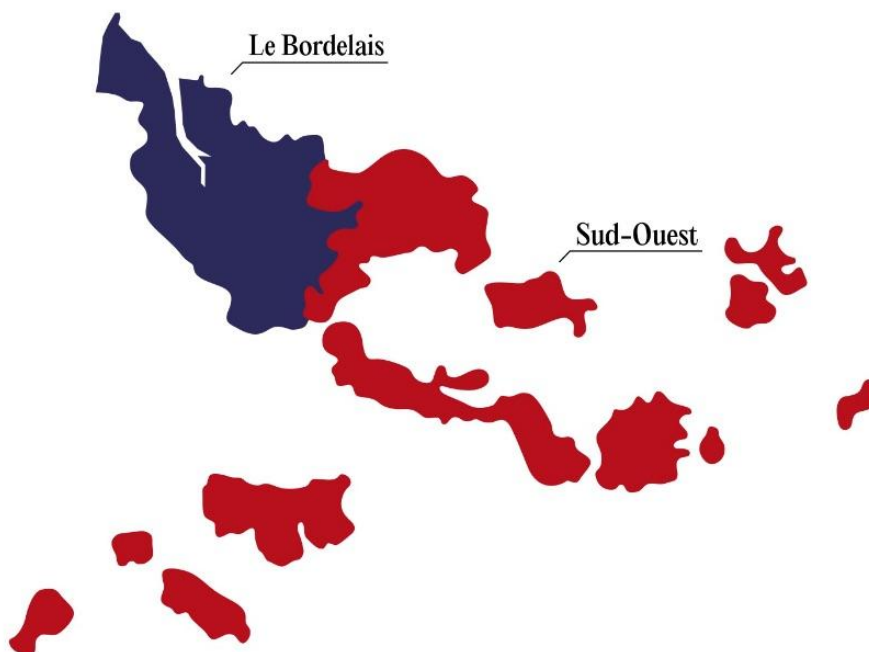

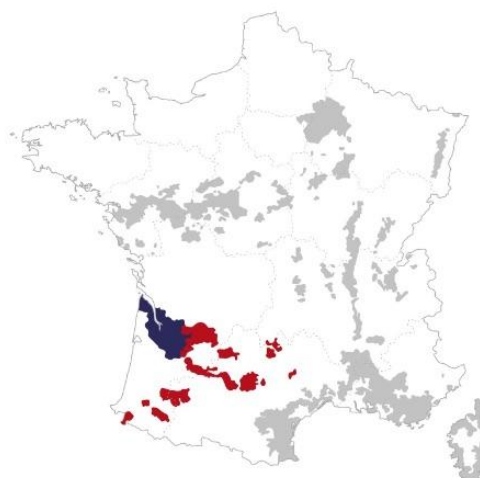


Bordeaux, the king of all wine. It holds the largest name of them all and trumps all other Appellations in terms of wine production, except for Languedoc. The Bordeaux household name has cemented itself in the wine world as the wine to have, whether it be expensive or not.

Bordeaux generally only needs to be broken down into two key areas, the Left Bank or the Right Bank. The two banks are separated by an estuary (Gironde) and two rivers (Dordogne & Garonne). On the Left you have names such as St-Estèphe, Pauillac, St-Julien and Margaux. And on the right you have the famous Pomerol and St-Emilion .

The main varieties of Bordeaux are more heavily focused on red wine, these being Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Malbec and Petit Verdot. With Bordeaux Blanc (White Bordeaux) only being made from Sauvignon and Semillon.

The left bank is more heavily focused on Cabernet Sauvignon making them richer and more powerful styles, while the right is more focused predominantly on Merlot dominant blends which make the wine more fruit forward and less of a tannin and body structure.
